Now, let's start with LESSON 2!

Let's get back to the text about an incident at the Roswell base. Last time you were asked to read the text and say: "What is it?" /"Is it a UFO?"/"Is it a balloon?"...

Your possible answers:

- -That CAN'T be a UFO.
- -It **MUST** be a balloon.
- -It **MIGHT** be a secret project...

You can notice that in these sentences we use MODAL VERBS (MUST, CAN'T, MIGHT, COULD).

We use them to MAKE GUESSES about the PRESENT.

MUST- mora da je tako...

CAN'T- ne moze biti ...

MIGHT= COULD- mozda je, moglo bi biti tako...

MUST (opposite) CAN'T!!!

EXAMPLES:

He always gets the best grades in his class. ----He **MUST** be the best student in his class. -----(*I'm SURE.*)

He sometimes gets the best grades.-----He **MIGHT/ COULD** be the best student. (<u>I'm NOT SURE.</u>)

He never gets good grades. -------He **CAN'T** be the best student. (I'm SURE he isn't.)

Modals of deduction (PRESENT) will be revised again in the next unit (10) together with Modals of deduction (PAST).

VOCABULARY: PROBLEMS (p.71)

CRYPTID- an animal whose existence is disputed
